Affordable Homes Now

Proposition D will make it easier for everyone to build housing that's affordable to teachers, firefighters, and working families. Prop D is supported by **GrowSF**, **Habitat for Humanity**, the **NorCal Carpenters Union**, and State Senator **Scott Wiener**.

No to Proposition E

Board of Supervisors anti-housing measure

Proposition E is an **anti-housing** measure put on the ballot by the Board of Supervisors. It has a poison-pill provision that will **kill Proposition D** (Affordable Homes Now), and make it even harder to build the housing we desperately need.

Constitutional right to abortion

Proposition 1 will protect women's right to privacy, reproductive choice, and access to pregnancy-related healthcare including the right to seek and obtain an abortion. All women deserve access to safe healthcare.
